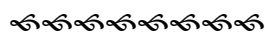

*The National Assessment Program in Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) results for 2015 have been released. Parents of students in Year 3 & 5 have received the NAPLAN reports. Congratulations to the students on their excellent results! We are very proud of you all!*

#### Here are the facts

**In all areas of testing (Reading, Writing, Language Conventions and Numeracy) the school average in both Year 3 and Year 5 was better than the national average!**

**In the 10 areas tested across Years 3 & 5 our school had a greater percentage of students in the top three bands compared to Diocesan schools and State schools in 8 areas!**

### **The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

August has brought us a number of important feast days and the 15<sup>th</sup> August was the Feast of the Assumption. This feast day commemorates Mary's body and soul being assumed into heaven and was also a time for us to reflect on the kind of life and person that Mary was and learn from her example.

In the Gospel of Luke we see Mary say *yes* to the angel Gabriel who asked her to bear the Son of God. She was chosen by God to take on the responsibility of being the mother of our Saviour. This took Mary by surprise but she responded by saying *yes*, "be it done unto me according to your word." Mary did not have an easy life. She watched her son strive to teach the Jewish people the message of God against powerful critics who opposed him. She witnessed his pain as Jesus, her only son, was accused of crimes he didn't commit and was tortured and crucified but throughout these difficult times, Mary stayed faithful and found strength in God.

What can we learn from Mary?

We can learn to be faithful followers like Mary and "walk with God always, even in moments of weakness" and always remember, "God is our Strength."

Breakfast and Afternoon tea are included in the daily cost.
