The Angelus

Early in 2013 we began to deliberately stop our daily routine at noon each day to pray the Angelus as a community. The Angelus is traditionally recited three times a day, morning, noon and evening. It is a simple practice of devotion that causes us to recall the Incarnation - the gift of God's Son. This prayer reminds us of the historical beginnings of our salvation and acts as a "reminder that there is more to life than the toil of everyday routines" *Archbishop Anthony Fisher*. The Archangel Gabriel visited Mary and asked her to bear the Son of God to become the Mother of the Redeemer. Mary was afraid but she responded by saying 'yes' to become the handmaid of the Lord. Finally, she says 'yes' to us all, whom she received as her children entrusted to her at the foot of the Cross. As we pray the Angelus, we join Mary by saying 'yes' to adhering to God's plan and God's love will take flesh in our lives.






