OUR Road to Bethlehem - 2016.

Last Sunday we began the liturgical preparation for the season of Advent. The four weeks of Advent allow us time to ponder how Jesus came into the world in such a stunningly humble way. Retailers and marketing agencies constantly draw our attention to the cash register and the glamour and glitz of the newest and best toys, clothes, fads, accessories and so on.

As a family you may be able to think of some ways that you can slow down and savor the season. Count down the days as you count your blessings. Marking off a family Advent calendar or creating an Advent wreath could help you prepare for Christmas.

The Gospel's call to stay awake, wait and prepare for the coming of the Lord is a call to continue the work of bringing about the Kingdom of God in our own lives, in our families in our workplaces, in our local communities and in the world in general

Lord as we journey to Bethlehem this year may we all take the time to be still and prepare.
