## **SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY**

School attendance plays a critical role in enhancing the lives of our students. Every day of attendance adds to a student's achievement and success at school. Both school and parents are responsible for promoting the regular attendance of students. Recently, I have noticed an increase in the number of students who are arriving late (almost on a daily basis). On one morning alone, last week, 21 students were signed in late! This is not acceptable, nor is it fair for the students who have missed valuable and important learning time. In this week's newsletter we have included a mini poster from the Catholic Education Office which clearly shows how much learning time is lost just by being 5 or 10 minutes late or leaving early on a regular basis and through frequent absences. Please take a moment to read the information on the poster and think about ways you can ensure your child is at school on time, every day. (8:55am - 3pm) A reminder that if your child arrives late and is not signed in by the adult who brought them, they will be recorded as 'Partial Absence-Unexplained'.
