LATE ARRIVALS TO SCHOOL

The school day at St John Vianney's begins at 8:55am and finishes at 3pm. Supervision begins at 8:30am (NOT EARLIER)!

We expect ALL students to be punctual. There may be times when for various reasons, students arrive late. In this case the adult who brings the student to school MUST fill in the late note at the office noting the arrival time and the reason for the late arrival.

Please DO NOT just drop your child at the gate if you are late. Students whose parents/carers do not complete a late note at the office will be recorded as 'Absence Unexplained' in our records.

UNMARKED UNIFORM and OTHER ITEMS

A plea to parents ... PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON CLOTHING (jackets, ties, hats etc) DRINK BOTTLES, LUNCH BOXES, and LUNCH BAGS!

School hats and jackets should be washed regularly, repaired if needed or replaced and re-labelled clearly with your child's name and class if this has faded or rubbed off.

Every day we end up with a pile of costly clothing and general items unclaimed. At the moment there is quite a collection in the Blue Room between the Year 3 & 4 classrooms. I know how costly uniforms are and we all need to be encouraging the children to be more responsible for the care of their belongings. 
