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### ST JOHN VIANNEY'S SUPER STAR ATHLETE CLARA NOURDINE HAS DONE IT AGAIN!

Clara competed over two days at Sydney Olympic Park, Homebush, last week at the NSW PSSA ATHLETICS CHAMPIONSHIPS. She was attempting to qualify for the NATIONALS which will be held in Canberra on 4th - 8th December.

Clara competed in three events over the two days.

She qualified for the 100m and 200m FINALS which was a total of six races.

Clara was also in **the Junior Girls Long Jump** where she had six jumps to complete.

It was very hot over the two days which made conditions extremely difficult for all athletes involved. Although, when looking at the results, Clara handled herself like a professional athlete would.

#### Clara's results were AMAZING !!!

Clara placed equal **4th** in the **100m Final** with a **PB of 13.92 seconds**, **4th** in the **200m Final** with another **PB of 28.38 seconds**.

The GREATEST result was that Clara placed **2nd** in the **Long Jump** with a **PB of 4.52m** which now means that Clara will be jumping out of her skin at the **NATIONALS!!!!**

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Whooping cough information for schools

There is an outbreak of whooping cough (pertussis) in NSW, mainly affecting schoolaged children.

Coughing spreads the infection to others nearby. Whooping cough can spread to anyone at home, including younger brothers and sisters. Whooping cough can be especially dangerous for babies.

Whooping cough starts like a cold and progresses to bouts of coughing that can last for many weeks. The infection can occur even in fully-vaccinated children. Older children may just have a cough that is persistent and may be worse at night.

- Children with these symptoms should see a doctor.
- If your doctor diagnoses whooping cough in your school-aged child, please let the school know and keep your child at home until they have taken 5 days of antibiotics. Keep coughing children away from babies.
- Whooping cough vaccines give good protection against infection but immunity fades with time. Check that all your children are up to date with their vaccines, due at 6 weeks, 4 months, 6 months, 4 years and 12 years of age (offered to all Year 7 students through the NSW school-based vaccination program). A booster is also recommended at 18 months of age.

A booster dose of vaccine is also recommended for adults that are in contact with young children, such as school staff and parents. Pregnant women are recommended to have a booster dose during each pregnancy and this is funded by NSW Health. Those who are new parents or carers of babies should consult their general practitioner about appropriate immunisation.
